## **THE PRESIDENTS CLUB OF DAYTON PRESENTATION OF CANDIDATE'S QUALIFICATIONS**

In selecting the winner of this year's **Citizen Legion of Honor Award**, the Awards Committee will base its decision on both the breadth and depth of the Candidate's contribution of volunteer service and leadership to the Greater Dayton region. **Volunteer service is the main criteria for consideration**, but a distinguished professional career will be considered in augmenting ones' volunteer leadership in the community. **This award is designed to recognize volunteer service.**

The Committee will look for the person who, in their opinion, best meets these qualifications:

1. The person whose unselfish volunteer community activities have benefited the greatest number of people...or;
2. The person whose single act has been of greatest benefit to the community...or;
3. The person whose self-sacrifice and unselfishness on behalf of others has not necessarily been acclaimed or sufficiently recognized.

To this end, it is requested that the presentation be prepared (typewritten is preferred) in document form and include statements covering the following priorities:

1. Civic leadership activities of Candidate:
  - a. Past (in chronological sequence)
  - b. Present
  - c. Awards and honors received
2. Contributions to the Candidate's chosen field of endeavor:
  - a. Past (in chronological sequence)
  - b. Present
  - c. Awards and honors received
3. The Nominating Sponsor's own reason(s) for nominating this individual for the **Citizen Legion of Honor Award**. It is suggested that the qualifications listed above in the first priority be used here to support the reason(s) given. Candidate must be a resident of the Miami Valley/ Dayton Metropolitan area. Nominations may be submitted by member clubs of the Presidents Club; past presidents of the Presidents Club; and past honorees of the **Citizen Legion of Honor Award**.
4. Nominees must be prepared to attend the annual award luncheon and presentation. It is a requirement that the recognized award recipient be in attendance at the October event.
