


In Case You Missed It: Last month's speaker was our new County Recorder, Stacey Benson-Taylor.



The National Exchange Club has teamed up with Veterans Matter (Veteransmatter.org) to support our unhoused Veterans. The Dayton & Springfield Exchange Clubs are teaming up to raise money for this very worthwhile cause.

This National Homeless Veterans Housing Program seamlessly integrates local communities, foundations, corporations, and Veterans groups with the VA & HUD to house your local heroes. We channel our support exclusively, directly, and immediately to move local chronically unhoused veterans off the streets and into permanent, supported housing. Although Veterans' Services provides support once the veteran is in a residence, they do not provide the funds for the initial deposit. Funds raised will provide the deposit money (approximately \$7-800 in the Miami Valley per applicant). In the Miami Valley region, as of June this year, there were 14 vouchers (≅ \$750) needed to supply deposits so unhoused veterans could start the process of actually being housed.

Program at a Glance

Veterans Matter helps the Veterans who need us the most – those who have nowhere else to go – they don't have the deposit required by the landlord, and they will be sent back to the streets, shelter, or car (this includes their children).

Veterans Matter partners with the VA homeless program social workers who help the veterans find appropriate housing of their choice, and then secure their long-term HUD VASH (VA Supportive Housing) Vouchers through the Department of Housing & Urban Development-Veterans Affairs.

When the veteran is ready to sign the lease and the veteran has nowhere else to find the deposit, the VA social workers access an on-line system, complete the short referral form requesting the deposit and hit send.

All conforming referrals are immediately approved. The social worker and landlord receive an email approval of the deposit and the check is sent the same day.

Rather than be sent back to the streets, shelter, or car, they cross the threshold into their own home for the brave in the land of the free. Most don't even know it was us who did it, so you will be the Guardian Angel who answered their prayer.

25% of the Heroes that Veterans Matter houses have children. Thousands of children are now able to sleep in their own beds, attend school, have clean clothes, and be proud of their new homes. The youth of today need security. Having a home and family around them provides this element of love and warmth.

Veterans Matter has housed thousands of Veterans and their families nationwide in 32 states and has attracted the support of over two dozen artists including Katy Perry, John Mellencamp, Dusty Hill, Luke Bryan, Kid Rock, Maren Morris and others.


