DANCED ACROSS SPAIN

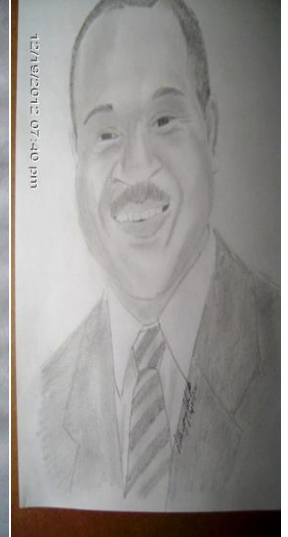
