Value of Membership in The Presidents Club of Dayton

The Presidents Club of Dayton is a Non-Profit organization that accomplishes many things in our community and with your help can do more:

We are providing paid members (only \$100 annual membership fee) free use of our Zoom Account for meetings with no time limit. Just schedule your meeting through Tony Massoud via presidentsclubdayton@aol.com to make sure the time you want is available. We will provide assistance for you to log on and use.

We are co-sponsors for the Bob Chiles Golf Outing, The Presidents Club of Dayton with Miami Valley Military Affairs Association since 1990 has donated over \$160,000 to the Fisher houses & over \$12,000 to First Sergeant's Association at WPAB. This year's event brochure is May 10thth.

Our Citizen Legion of Honor Award is one of the most Prestigious Volunteer Awards in our community. We are donating four scholarships a year to Sinclair College each at \$2500 a year. Our current endowment for the four scholarships is self-sustaining to help maintain higher education for worthy students in our area who achieve high scholastics and volunteerism. The Presidents Club has raised over \$400,000 for Sinclair Scholarships because organizations like yours over the years with their \$100 membership fee, and fund-raising support have helped raised these monies.

Each day more and more of our veterans are passing away. The last veteran from World War I passed away in February 2011; our World War II veterans are dying at the rate of approximately 1,000 a day. For many younger people, conflicts as recent as Vietnam seem to be "old war movies". Unfortunately, many times when a veteran dies all of his or her history dies with them - we want to bring to life the stories of our veterans and provide a tangible link to them.

Donations ensure our continued growth, and preservation of our veteran's stories.

What types of things can you donate?

- Uniforms
- Insignias
- Medals
- Photographs
- Captured enemy trophies.
- Anything that will help tell our veteran's stories, especially those from Ohio.

Nothing is too small or insignificant. We are a 501c3 tax-exempt organization and donations are tax deductible to the limit allowed by the Internal Revenue Service.

We can also use items that you feel may be too damaged or worn to restore. Artifacts may be used to support our educational programs such as Operation FOOTLOCKER (a virtual field trip) and the Speakers Bureau.

Some come for a day, some for a year, some return often for treatment for ongoing issues such as cancer care. The houses are fully stocked with everything that is needed, so the patients and families can focus on one thing, which is healing. We pride ourselves on being a "home away from home" that is tranquil. Community is also often built between the families in the houses as they can relate to others facing similar challenges, and life-long bonds have been forged as a result.

A gift to FNHI directly benefits the guests of our houses. We are proud of our 4-star rating with Charity Navigator, which is an organization that monitors and rates non-profits and their stewardship of donations. FNHI has earned and enjoys the top rating year over year.

There are many ways to support the Fisher/Nightingale Houses, Inc. We have volunteers that engage in many ways, from helping with fundraising events to operating our popcorn machine in the lobby of the Wright-Patterson AFB Medical Center.
