Our Wednesday, February 21, 2024, meeting will be a 45-minute tour of the historic/renovated Dayton Arcade. The Arcade was first built in 1902 and was an important asset to the Dayton community. It served as a hub for shopping, dining, and entertainment. It was known for its distinctive architectural style, featuring elements of Beaux-Arts and Romanesque Revival design.

After years of disrepair, The Dayton Arcade has been renovated and comprises a series of interconnected buildings and has been transformed into a mixed-use development, combining residential spaces, offices, retail establishments, and community spaces. The Arcade management is making an exception and providing The Presidents Club of Dayton a tour of this magnificent Dayton Gem.

Celebrate Black History Month, open your hearts and minds to the essential contributions that African slaves and their descendants made in making America the great country it is today. With my career in Real Estate and my husband a home builder, I would like to introduce you to Mr. Paul Williams (1894-1980), a prominent American architect who designed



homes, and commercial buildings in Los Angeles, Arizona, Las Vegas, Palm Springs, New York, Washington D.C., and Tennessee. Williams is an example of what perseverance against all odds can do. He and his brother were orphaned when he was 4 years old. Many unproven stories of who raised the two brothers are unfounded. However, someone encouraged Paul Williams' love of art.

Paul Williams was known for his significant contributions to architecture, especially during the mid-20th century. He gained recognition for his work in designing luxurious homes for celebrities, including many in Hollywood specifically, Frank Sinatra, Lucille Ball. Notably, Williams was one of the few African American architects

practicing during the era of racial segregation in the United States.

Some of his famous projects include the iconic Theme Building at Los Angeles International Airport (LAX), the first building at the airport designed for a specific purpose rather than as a terminal. The building that I frequented in Los Angeles that he designed is Saks Fifth Ave. on Wilshire Blvd. in Beverly Hills. Williams also designed numerous elegant residences, commercial buildings, and public institutions. His architectural style ranged from traditional to modern, and he was skilled in adapting his designs to the preferences of his clients.

Throughout his career, Paul Williams faced challenges due to racial discrimination, yet he persevered and left an indelible mark on American architecture. He graduated from USC in 1919, received his architectural license in 1921, started his own practice in 1922. He became the first African American member of the American Institute of Architects (AIA) in 1923 and later served

as its national president. His legacy continues to be celebrated for his talent, innovation, and trailblazing achievements in the field of architecture.
