## February 2026 Calendar of Observances

- February 1, 2026 Black History Month
- February 12, 2026 Lincoln's Birthday Honors Abraham Lincoln, 16th President of the United States, and remembered for his leadership during the Civil War and his role in ending slavery.
- February 16, 2026 Presidents Day, a federal holiday recognizing the presidents of the United States, most notably George Washington and Abraham Lincoln, and the legacy of national leadership.
- February 18, 2026 Ash Wednesday, a Christian holy day marking the beginning of Lent, a season of reflection, fasting, and preparation for Easter.
- Evening Feb 16 – Feb 17, 2026 Ramadan begins at sunset on February 16, with the first full day of fasting observed on February 17. It is a sacred month for Muslims focused on fasting, prayer, reflection, and community.
