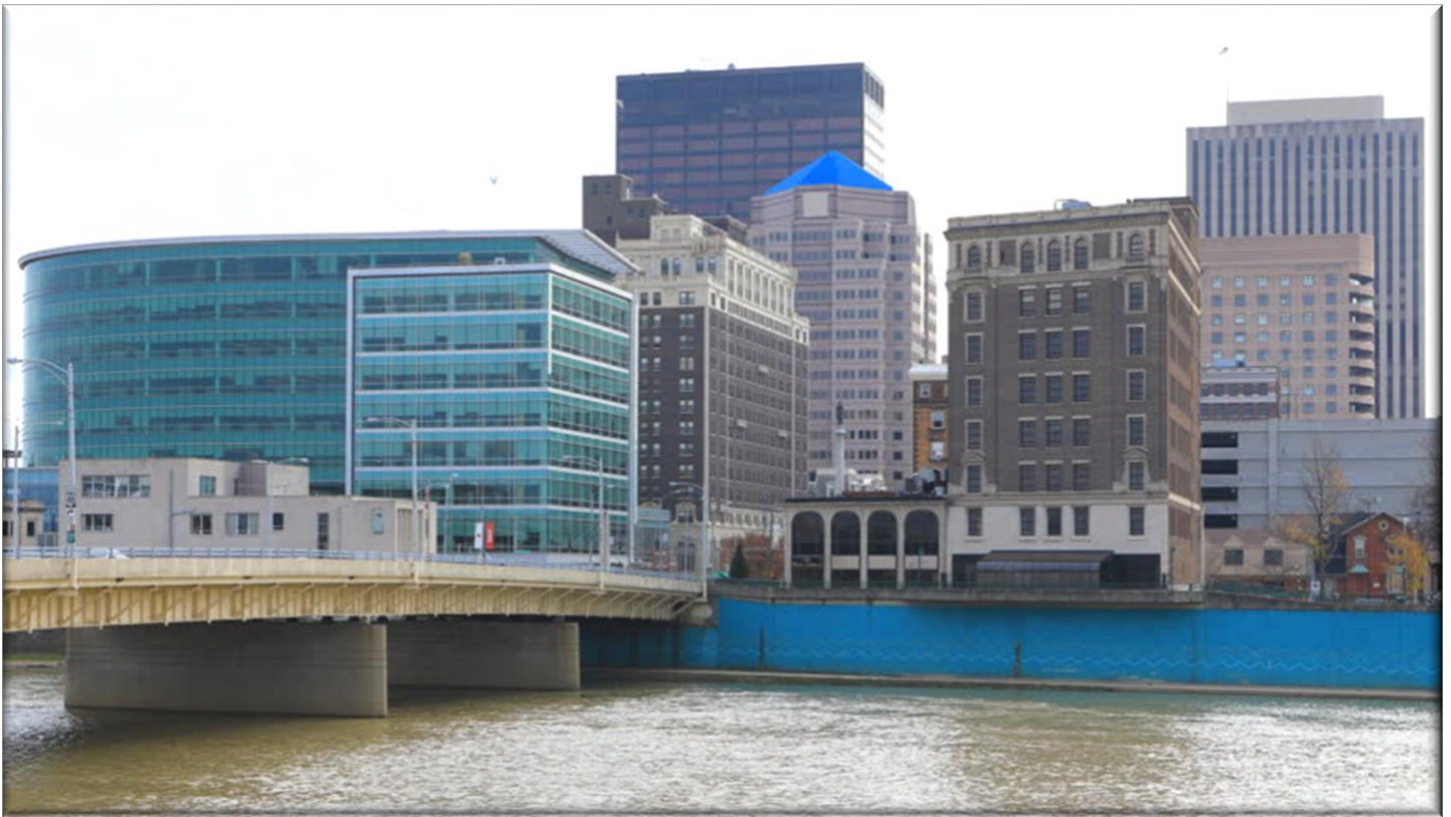

The Presidents Club of Dayton honors Dr. Cassie Barlow with their top volunteer award.

DAYTON, Ohio—The Presidents Club of Dayton is pleased to announce that Cassie Barlow will be the 72nd recipient of the region’s 2023 Citizen Legion of Honor Award. The award, given annually since 1951 (2020 COVID exception) is the oldest, most continuous and prestigious recognition of volunteer servant leadership in the Dayton region.

Dr. Cassie Barlow is a local, regional and national leader who has been a driving force behind higher education and workforce preparation in the Miami Valley Region.

After a distinguished career in the United States Air Force, culminating as the 88<sup>th</sup> Air Base Wing and Installation Commander at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, she settled in Dayton permanently serving as Executive Director of Wright State University’s Aerospace Professional Development Center; and now currently as President of Strategic Ohio Council on Higher Education (SOCHE).

Dr. Barlow received her Ph.D. in Industrial/Organizational Psychology from Rice University in Houston TX. She has been an outstanding servant leader well beyond her professional career. She has used her unique experiences to help our region attract and train workers in the aerospace and defense industries, all while serving on a number of distinct community boards, chairing several of them.

Cassie, as she is known to many, has served as a Board leader on The Dayton Foundation; Miami Valley Military Affairs Association and Girl Scouts of Western Ohio and has served on numerous other area Boards including the Dayton Area Chamber of Commerce; Air Camp; The Abilities Connection; Tait Foundation; Blue Star Advisors Board and many others who have prospered with her leadership. Cassie has also been recognized by numerous organizations for her life-long service.
