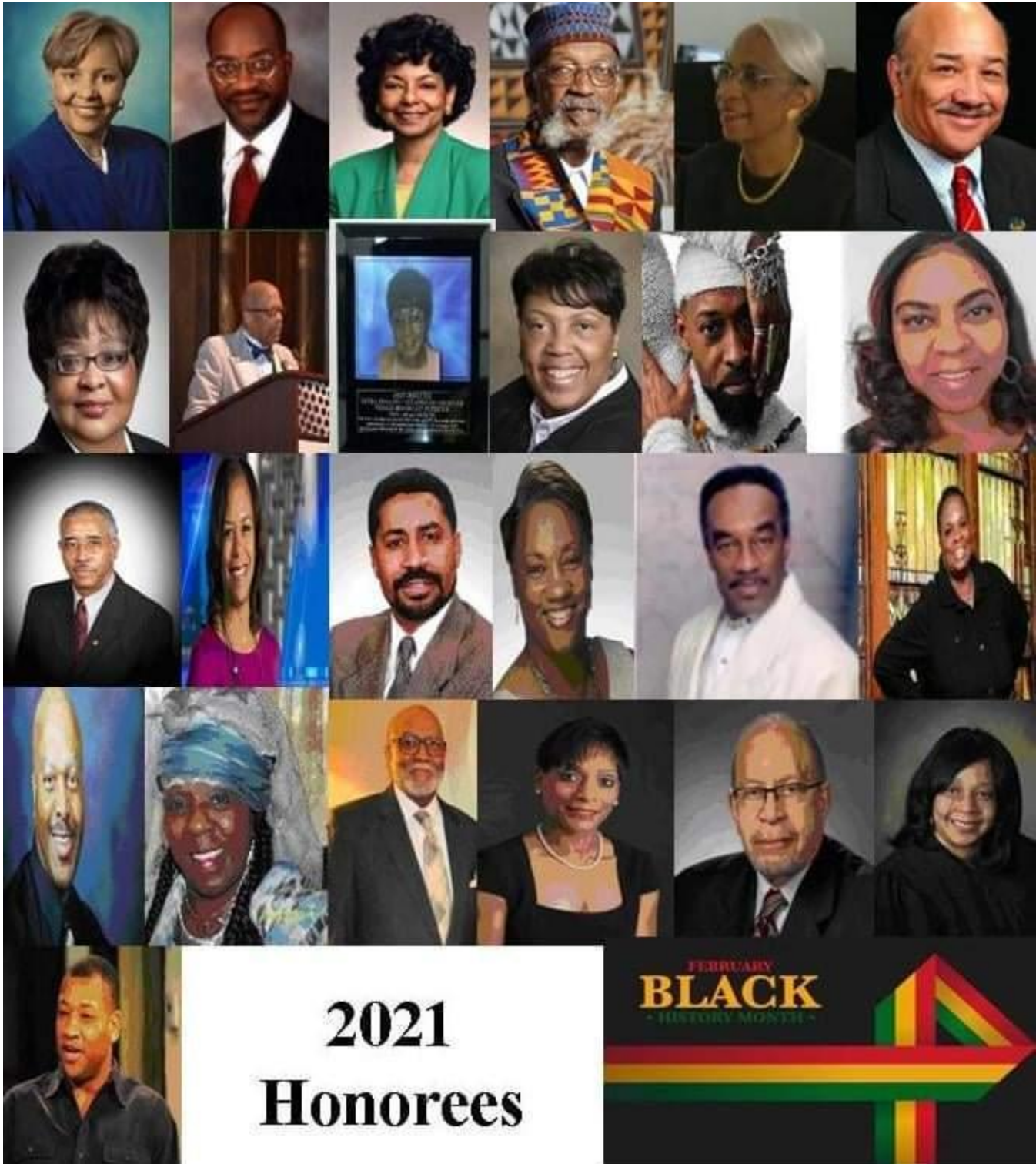

- Add the event to the calendar and “SAVE”, this will ensure your time and day are scheduled. Do not forget to set your start time and end time because other organizations will need to schedule.

- Use this email to notify that you have scheduled your event and a schedule will be set up for your organization on **Zoom** and the information to use Zoom will be sent to you with log-on and password.
- Please email the details to tmassoud211@cs.com and include in the details of the meeting who the **Leader** will be with their **email address**, do you want a **password** for your participants to enter Zoom or Waiting Room or Both. Do you want your meeting **videotaped**? **We will setup your organization's Zoom meeting for you if you need help.**
- Use someone who is familiar with Zoom. It is quite easy to use with a computer, laptop, smartphone, or telephone.
